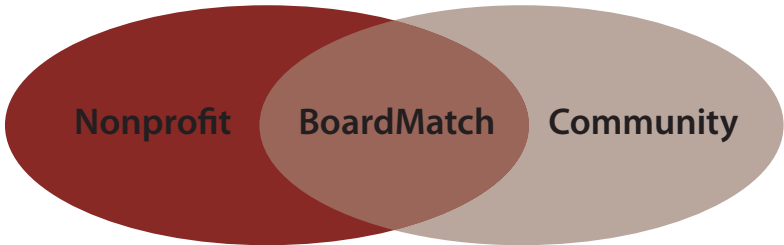


BoardMatch Marin

What is BoardMatch Marin?

BoardMatch Marin, a program of the Center for Volunteer and Nonprofit Leadership, helps create excellence in nonprofit governance through a comprehensive array of services. We provide recruitment and placement of qualified board members, as well as expert training and consultation—with services available to both prospective candidates as well as current board members and executive staff. Currently, BoardMatch Marin is the only board matching program in the Bay Area that offers individual guidance and support from coordinators.

- To assist Marin nonprofits in identifying, recruiting, and retaining board members
- To support and grow community leadership in the nonprofit sector
- To provide training and consulting resources on nonprofit governance

Additional Board Development Services

Board Development Trainings

The Center offers board development trainings throughout the year, including: *Board 101*, *Board 201*, *Strategic Board Recruitment*, and *The Art of the Ask*.

Board Development Coaching and Consulting

Professional guidance on all aspects of board development, including board roles and responsibilities, recruitment and retention, and change management.

Governance Tune-Up

Customized workshop designed for your board at your location. Areas covered include: Board Roles and Responsibilities, Ethics & Fiduciary Responsibility, Risk Management, Executive Director Evaluation, and Transition Planning.

Nonprofit Resource Center & Library

Conduct research and review current publications about board service, best practices, and board management issues.

Getting Started is Easy

CANDIDATES

1) Submit an online application

2) Begin the match process

Consult with a BoardMatch coordinator to identify opportunities best suited to your interests and background. Coordinator will help facilitate referrals and introductions to nonprofit agencies with board openings.

3) Attend Training

Attend our board trainings (*optional*) to equip yourself with an overview of the roles and responsibilities required for serving on a board.

4) Receive ongoing support

Continue to receive guidance during and after the board match process.

AGENCIES

1) Submit an online application

2) Begin the match process

Consult with the Center to identify specific skill sets and characteristics for your board members.

3) Review referrals

Choose desired board match candidates from those referred to you. BoardMatch coordinator will facilitate the introduction process or notify the candidates if you are not interested.

4) Receive ongoing support

Continue to receive guidance and attend board trainings to equip your organization with effective board governance strategies.
