COURSE DESCRIPTION

- 5K timed course starting at Old Courthouse Square, Santa Rosa, CA
- All levels and ages welcome (under 13 must be accompanied by an adult)
- Wheelchair accessible
- Well behaved dogs on leashes are allowed but must be registered (2 dog max)
- Strollers are welcome
- Sorry, no bicycles, scooters or skates

CVNL Members **\$40** through March 10/**\$50** after. Non-Members, **\$125** through March 10/**\$135** after.

INDIVIDUALS

Each person who wants to participate in the race and create a Human Race fundraising page must register for the race at humanracenow.org. All registrants are able to form and join fundraising teams and participate as a group! We encourage nonprofits and businesses to create teams of their own!

Individual Registration Fees: Early Bird rates thru April 7, 2022!

Entry fee: • Adult 5k, **\$35** until April 7 /**\$45** /**\$55** race day

- Youth 5k (13-18) \$25 until April 7/\$35 /\$45 race day
- Dog walker (max 2 dogs), \$40 until April 7/\$50/\$60 race day

COLLECTING DONATIONS - IN PERSON.

If your team collects in person donations, a team captain may drop them off, **by appointment only,** at CVNL Santa Rosa office.

- 3. All donations delivered in person must be by appointment and must include a donation form.

Donations will be accepted up to May 20, 2022 Online and in person, by appointment only.

THANKING YOUR DONORS

Participants are responsible for providing their *offline* donors with a tax receipt using CVNL's tax identification number. A template is provided. Receipts for *online* donations will be sent by CVNL.

FUNDRAISING DISTRIBUTION

CVNL will begin check distribution to all organizations **June 20, 2022.** All checks will be accompanied by a donation report.
