Summary: The Mental Health Therapist offers guidance and support to individuals, couples, families and groups who are dealing with issues that affect their mental health and well-being. The position requires a master's degree or clinical license in Social Work, Counseling, or Psychology. The agency offers supervision for interns that are seeking clinical hours toward licensure. We provide individual supervision and group consultation on a weekly basis. This job is a great opportunity to enjoy clinical work with a supportive team.
